NOTE: *Back from the Brink: on October 19, 2019, the NH Conference UCC Annual Meeting unanimously passed the Back from the Brink Resolution and endorsed the national initiative for the U.S. to take the needed steps to prevent nuclear on this topic at our Annual Meeting on October 19, 2019. Now it's up to each NH UCC congregation and congregant to learn about these issues.

Brief Description of Presentations

- **Rev. John Buttrick – *Back from the Brink****: A Call to Prevent Nuclear War. The driving force for this national movement is the existential threat posed by nuclear weapons and the recognition that there is no meaningful medical or humanitarian response to nuclear war. We will consider The Union of Concerned Scientists five steps to prevent a nuclear war.
- **Rev. Gray Fitzgerald- *Back from the Brink***: During the Cold War we were very aware of the threat of nuclear weapons. In the years since then we have become less aware and particularly less cognizant of the growing possibility of a nuclear war. Most of us are not aware of the multiple times a nuclear holocaust has nearly erupted, sometimes completely by accident. The Union of Concerned Scientists is taking the initiative to make us aware of the danger and is promoting a five-step program to prevent a nuclear war from breaking out.
- **Janet Zeller - *Back from the Brink****: The world has never been closer to nuclear war than we are today. Matthew 5:9 tells us “Blessed are the peacemakers for they shall be called the children of God.” Preventing destruction of the earth by a nuclear holocaust would be the greatest peacemaking endeavor possible. The Union of Concerned Scientists has a 5-step program to back us away from this brink. Learn about those 5-steps and the opportunity coming to the NHCUCC to support this effort through the *Back from the Brink Resolution* at NHCUCC’s Annual Meeting 2019.
