Title: Becoming a Creation Justice Church

Whether it is taking on the climate crisis or addressing the damage caused by air pollution on children, environmental ministries could not have a higher purpose or calling than they do now. If the followers of Jesus today care about the air we breathe, the water we drink, or the world in which we live, then environmental justice ministry should undoubtedly be a central strand in any church's DNA. In this presentation, the Rev. Dr. Brooks Berndt will focus on exploring how that can be done – how congregations can discern their calling to care for creation, how they can reinvigorate their sense of covenant with God, how they can join one of the most exciting movements in the world today, and how they can foster a deeper sense of connection to God, each other, and the world in which we live.



Rev. Dr. Brooks Berndt is the UCC Minister of Environmental Justice, and author of two books: *Sounding the Trumpet: How Churches Can Answer God's Call to Justice* (co-authored with Rev. Dr. J. Alfred Smith, Sr.) and *Cathedral on Fire! A Church Handbook for the Climate Crisis*. He writes and edits the UCC environmental justice newsletter called [The Pollinator](#).
