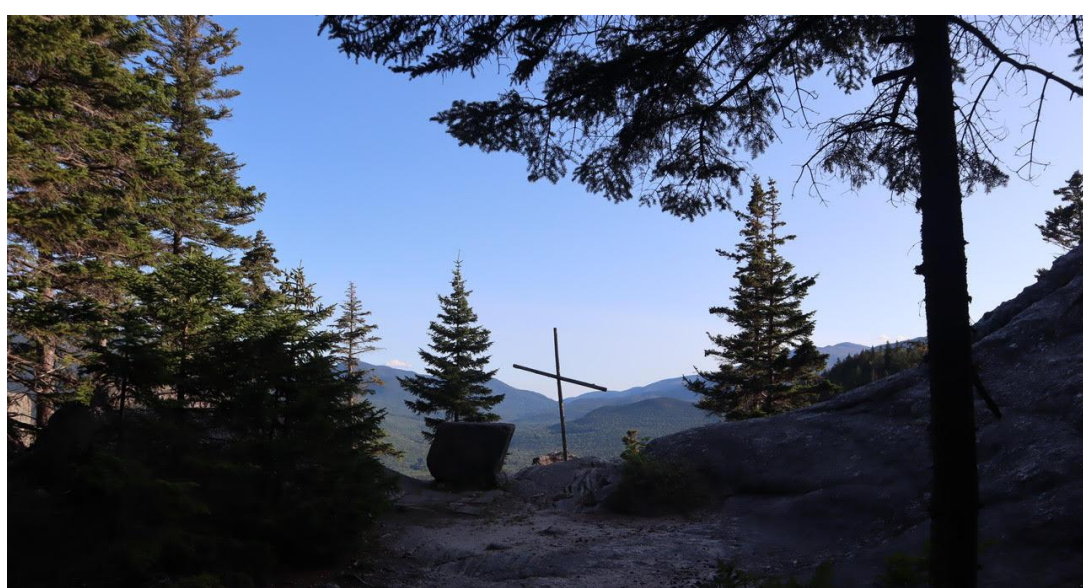


OUR MISSION
